Difficulty:

Intermediate

Size: 3.5" high x 4.5" long

Materials

- ❖ Plain, smooth worsted weight yarn, 20 yds Coffee (dark brown), 30 yds Café (light brown)
- ❖ G/6 (4.25mm) hook
- ❖ Stuffing or fiberfill
- ❖ Yarn Needle

Gauge: 8 rows x 7.5 sts in sc = 2"

Abbreviations

ch = chain
dc = double crochet
inc = increase

rep = repeat
sc = single crochet
US pattern conventions used.

Directions

Side (make 2):

Row 1: W/Cafe, ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each across. (16 sc) Turn.
Rows 2-5: Ch 1, sc across. (16 sc) Turn.
Row 6: Switch to Coffee. Ch 1, sc across. (16 sc) Turn.
Row 7: Ch 1, sc across. (16 sc) Turn.
Row 8: Switch to Cafe, ch 1. Sc across. (16 sc) Turn.
Rows 9-12: Ch 1, sc across. (16 sc) Turn.
Finish off.

Bottom:

Row 1: W/Cafe, ch 2, Make 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc 2, turn.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc, sc inc. (3 sc) Turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc 3. Turn.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc inc, sc 2. (4 sc) Turn.
Row 6: Ch 1, sc across. (4 sc) Turn.
Row 7: Ch 1, sc 3, sc inc. (5 sc) Turn.
Row 8: Ch 1, sc across, turn. (5 sc)
Row 9: Ch 1, sc inc, sc 4. (6 sc) Turn.
Row 10: Ch 1, sc across. (6 sc) Turn.
Row 11: Ch 1, sc 5, sc inc. (7 sc) Turn.
Row 12: Ch 1, sc across. (7 sc) Turn.
Row 13: Ch 1, sc inc, sc across. (8 sc) Turn.
Row 14: Ch 1, sc across. (8 sc) Turn.
Row 15: Ch 1, sc 7, sc inc. (9sc) Finish off.

Back:

Row 1: Ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *dc in next st, sc in next st, rep from * across. (9 sts) Turn.
Row 2: Ch 2, dc, *sc in next st, dc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc, *dc in next st, sc in next st. Rep from * across. Turn.
Rows 4-9: Repeat rows 2 and 3 alternately. Finish off.

Top:

Row 1: Ch 2, make 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn.
Row 2: Ch 2, dc, sc. (2 sts) Turn.
Row 3: Ch 2, [dc and sc in next st] 2 times. (4 sts) Turn.
Row 4: Ch 2, [dc in next st, sc in next st] 2 times. (4 sts) Turn.
Row 5: Ch 2, [dc and sc in next st], dc, sc, [dc and sc in next st]. (6 sts) Turn.
Row 6: Ch 2, [dc in next st, sc in next st] 3 times. (6 sts) Turn.
Row 7: Ch 2, [dc and sc in next st], [dc in next st, sc in next st] 2 times, [dc in next st, sc in next st]. (8 sts) Turn.
Rows 8-9: Ch 2, [dc in next st, sc in next st] 4 times. (8 sts)
Row 10: Ch 2, [dc and sc in next st], [dc in next st, sc in next st] 3 times. [Dc and sc in next st.] (10 sts) Turn.
Row 11: Ch 2, [dc in next st, sc in next st] 5 times. (10 sts) Finish off.

Assembly

Note: All seams in this pattern should be made as follows. Place pieces to be joined atop each other, wrong sides together; sew by moving needle up and down through both pieces about 1/8" in from the edge, *not* by going around the outside of the corner. Assembling the pieces in this way results in a sharper corner and sturdier edge, helping to maintain the shape of the piece.

1. With Café, sew the two Side pieces together along one vertical edge.

2. Place the narrow end of the Bottom piece into the corner just formed by the Side pieces, and sew two long edges of Bottom to the two bottom edges of the Sides. Finish off with Café yarn.
3. With Coffee yarn, sew short edge of Top triangle to short edge of Back.
4. Fit Top and Back to Bottom and Sides, placing narrow end of Top in the corner formed by the Sides.
5. Sew together until only one edge remains open, allowing the edges of the dark brown pieces to overhang slightly.
6. Stuff cake, sew completely closed. Weave in and conceal all ends.
