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Difficulty: Advanced Beginner

Finished Size: Approx. 24" circumference before adding ribbon (which may be used to tighten fit)

Gauge: 12 sts x 5 rows = 4"
in dc, ch 1 mesh

Abbreviations

ch = chain
ch-sp = chain-space
dc = double crochet
hdc = half-double crochet
rnd = round
sk = skip

Materials

- ❖ Approx. 55 yds Debbie Mumm Traditions (149yds/ 136m per 80g/ 2.8 oz skein); worsted weight.
- ❖ K (6.50mm) hook
- ❖ Approx. 1 yd 5/8" ribbon
- ❖ Yarn Needle



Directions

Rnd 1: Ch 3. [Dc, ch 1] 6 times in the 3rd ch from the hook. (12 sts) Join rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, *[dc, ch 1, dc in same st] in dc, ch 1, sk ch (from previous row). Repeat from * around, (24 sts) join.

Rnd 3: Ch 2. *Dc in next st, ch 1, sk ch, [dc, ch 1, dc in same st] in next st; ch 1, sk ch. Repeat from * around. (36 sts) Join.

Rnd 4: Ch 2. *[Dc in next st, ch 1, sk ch] 2 times, [dc in next st, ch 1, dc in same st] in next st, ch 1, sk ch. Repeat from * around, (48 sts) join.

Rnd 5: Ch 2. *[Dc in next st, ch 1, sk ch] 3 times, [dc in next st, ch 1, dc in same st] in next st, ch 1, sk ch. Repeat from * around, (60 sts) join.

Rnds 6-9: Ch 2, *[dc in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st]. Repeat from * around, (60 sts) join.

Rnd 10: Ch 2, hdc in each st and ch-sp around (60 hdc), join.

Rnd 11: *[Ch 2, sl st in next st], repeat from * around. Join, finish off, weave in ends.

To finish, weave ribbon through last row of mesh as pictured and tie a bow.
