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Skill Level: Intermediate
Finisked Sïze: To fit ages 3 and under, [3-6, 8-adult small]
Directions are given for the smallest size, with all other sizes in parenthesis.
Gauge: 19 sts x 28 rows $=4 "$ in stockinette

## Abberciations:

co = cast on
$\mathrm{k}=$ knit
k2tog $=$ knit 2 together
$\mathrm{p}=$ purl
rnd = round

## Materials

* Red Heart Super Saver (7 oz/198 g per 364 yd/333m skein), about 1 [ $1 \frac{1}{2}, 2$ ] oz MC, small
 amount CC, small amount black.
* Set of 4 US 6/4mm double-pointed needles

Tapestry needle

## Directions

With MC, co 24 [28, 36]. Distribute evenly on three needles and join, being careful not to twist stitches. Cuff: Work in k2, p2 rib around until cuff measures $1^{3 / 4}\left[2,2^{1 / 4}\right.$ ] inches long.
$\mathfrak{H t a n d}$ : Begin working in stockinette: knit every stitch around until portion
above ribbing measures 3 [ $3^{3 / 4}, 4^{1 / 2}$ ] inches long.
' $\mathcal{T}$ ae' Decreases: Rearrange stitches with $12[14,18]$ stitches on one needle (Needle 1) and $6[7,9]$ on each of the other two.
Rnd 1: Working first from Needle 1, k1, k2tog, k across until 3 stitches remain, k2tog, k1 (10 [12, 16] sts). On next needle, k1, k2tog, k across (5 [6,

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8] sts). On next needle, $k$ across until 3 sts remain; k2tog, k1 (5 [6, 8] sts). Rnd 2: Repeat Rnd 1: $(8[10,12])$ sts remaining on Needle 1, (4 $[5,6]$ ) on each of the other two. If making the smallest size, skip to round 5 . Rnd 3: Repeat Rnd 1: [8, 10] sts remaining on Needle 1, $[4,5]$ on each of the other two. If making the medium size, skip to round 5 . Rnd 4: Repeat Rnd 1: 8 sts remaining on Needle 1, 4 on each of the other two.
Rnd 5: (Resume for all sizes) Beginning on Needle 1, bind off 2 sts, k 4 , bind off 2 sts. On the next needle, bind off 2 sts, k2. On the last needle,
k2, bind off 2. You should have 8 live sts remaining.
Jangue: Rearrange stitches as evenly as possible. Switch to CC. Rnds 1-8: Knit around. If making smallest size, skip to Fork. Rnd 9: Knit around. If making medium size, skip to Fork.
Rnd 10: Knit around.
Fark: Split stitches onto two needles (to the right and left of center) so that there are 4 sts on each needle. Work one set of sts in I-cord for 6 rows; bind off.
Join yarn to work other set of sts; work in I-cord for 6 rows. Bind off.

## Finishing

1) Flatten snake puppet. With MC, sew closed the gaps left by the bound off sts.
2) Use CC if necessary to neaten the ends of the fork in the tongue.
3) With black, embroider on eyes.
4) Weave in all ends.
