## DIFFICULTY: Intermediate

SIZE: Approx. 3" long, including stem

GAUGE: Gauge is not terribly important as long as it is firm.

## Abbreriations

ch = chain
dec $=$ decrease (pull up a loop in each of next 2 sts and work together as directed) hdc = half-double crochet inc = increase (make 2 in next stitch)
rnd = round

sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch

## Materials

* Worsted Weight yarn: approx. 6 yds red and 3 yds green per berry. Samples shown in Patons Classic Merino (Bright Red) and Knitpicks Swish Superwash (Dublin).
- G (4.25mm) hook
* Small amount stuffing
- Yarn Needle


## Directions

Rnd 1: With red, ch 3. Make 4 hdc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook. Join rnd with a sl st.
Rnd 2: Ch 2. [hdc, hdc inc] 2 times. (6 hdc) Join.
Rnd 3: Ch 2, [hdc, hdc inc] 3 times. (9 hdc) Join.
Rnd 4: Ch 2, [hdc 2, hdc inc] 3 times. (12 hdc) Join.
Rnd 5: Ch 2, [hdc 3, hdc inc] 3 times. ( 15 hdc) Join.
Rnd 6: Ch 2, [hdc, hdc dec] 5 times. (10 hdc) Join.
Rnd 7: Finish red, switch to green. Gently stuff strawberry: be careful not to overstuff as it causes gapping. *Sl st in next st. Ch 3 , sl st in same st. Repeat from * around (10 chain-bumps). Join rnd with sl st.
Rnd 8: Ch 1. *Pull up a loop in next sl st, sk chain-bump, pull up a loop in next sl st. Yarn over, draw hook through both loops. (1 sc) Skip next chain-bump. Repeat from * around. (5 sc) Join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1. Draw up a loop in each of the next 3 sts; yarn over, draw hook through all 3 loops. Decrease over next 2 sts. ( 2 sc ) Sl st in first st. Finish off, weave in all ends.
